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SAMPLE RESEARCH PAPER INTRODUCTION & OUTLINE:

In Lord of the Flies, William Golding presents a power struggle between two boys with distinctly different leadership styles. Fair-minded Ralph, democratically elected, loses his position of authority to self-serving, power hungry Jack. Jack, a young dictator, bears much similarity to Russian Bolshevik leader Joseph Stalin. Both Jack and Stalin were ruthless, ambitious, argument #1, deceitful [argument #2], and savage [argument #3].

Para. #2: Topic sentence about argument #1:

Despite religious upbringing, Joseph Stalin and Jack Merridew both hustled for power.

List in point form (in your own words) and organize (if number) the points you wish to make, pertaining to ruthless ambition. Include in your points the parallels you wish to draw (similarities you want to make) with Jack.

1. Stalin—active member in Bolshevik faction of Russian Social Democratic Labour Party
2. under Lenin, attained high position as editor of propagandist paper "Pravda" ("Truth")
3. under leader Ralph, Jack (who also had a religious upbringing) becomes head of the choir ("army"/hunters)
4. ETC.

Para. #3: Topic sentence, including transitional, about argument #2. Next: point form list of ideas on deceitfulness with parallels to Jack.

In addition to [transitional] ruthless ambition, Stalin practiced deceit to gain and retain power.

Para. #4: Topic sentence, including transitional, on argument #3. Next: point form list of ideas on savagery with parallels to Jack.

Para. #5: Concluding paragraph: the "inverted hourglass." NO NEW INFO. Reiterate (restate by rewording) your thesis statement. Then end with one or two less specific (more general) statements.

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
